

In recent years there has been an increase in reported avalanches in this area. Be sure to have a beacon, probe, shovel and other necessary first aid items, as well as check for weather conditions and perform compression tests to determine the safety level to base your decisions on.

Remember that in theory, any slope with an angle and snow on it could be an avalanche hazard. Here we have outlined in red the "Avalanche Risk Areas" which have had previous reports of avalanches, and are especially prone to danger.
